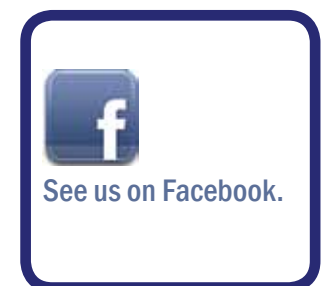

## 2010: Helping Women Succeed

During 2010 the full program of Women Blessing Women served 244 participants. Of those women, 237 were active participants. Approximately 25 percent of WBW participants are employed. During 2010, 13 enrolled in college, 15 earned their GED, and 30 percent advanced their grade level.

Women Blessing Women's employment/college readiness program addresses the root causes of poverty: lack of high school diploma, job readiness, job skills and behaviors. The program achieves its goals through tutoring, one-on-one mentoring and group sessions including:

- Résumé development
- On-line applications
- Job skills
- Work ethics
- Basic computer skills
- Basic literacy skills
- Career opportunities
- GED (General Education Diploma)
- Learning positive behaviors
- Relationship skills
- Conflict resolution
- Money management
- Women's health issues
- Self-esteem/confidence
- Stress/anxiety reduction
- Goal-setting
- Spiritual retreats
- Educational assessment testing

### Spiritual Retreats and Empowerment Workshops Heal and Inspire

Facilitated by community volunteers, agencies and lay members, Women Blessing Women held **some 600 empowerment workshops** in 2010. Some of the workshop topics included Goal Setting, Spiritual Growth, Character Building, Baggage-Free, Budgeting, Journaling, Public Speaking, Health Screenings, Nutrition/Fitness, Self Esteem, Time Management, Conflict Resolution, Healthy Relationships, Benefit Bank and Domestic Violence.

Spiritual Retreats serve as an important component in developing a healthier spiritual foundation for the women. The Spiritual Retreats are planned for each quarter of the year: March, May, July, October and December. Some of the 2010 Spiritual Retreats were facilitated by The Ursuline Sisters, Sheila Otto, Ministers Karrie Jackson, Patricia Harris, Felica Clark, Helen Baxter and our own Audrey Reed. Special thanks to all of our volunteers and staff who give their time to empower our women in mind, body and spirit.

### Additional Programs Provide Learning Opportunities

Participants read the book *Growing up Black in White*, by author Kevin D. Hofmann. After the women completed it, they attended a book-signing on Oct. 26 at Lagrange Branch Library. The author signed each participant's book. Special thanks to volunteers Kay Shrewsbury and Sue Nowak for donating 25 books and Kevin Hofmann for sharing his experiences with the participants.

Women also participated in a Career Week program, Sept. 9-13. Workshops included proper dress attire, interviewing skills and mock interview practice. The week ended with a field trip to the Franciscan Care Center, Sylvania. Participants heard from facilitators in the medical professions and a Lourdes College representative. Thanks to Sr. Jordan Schaefer for arranging facilitators.

**W**omen Blessing Women benefitted from the dedication of 118 volunteers serving our organization during 2010. Our talented volunteers worked in various capacities as mentors, tutors, instructors, coaches, leaders, special event assistants, financial, administrative and marketing consultants. They served 7,289.50 hours, with an in-kind service value of \$119,845. Without the commitment and skills of our volunteers, we could not continue to provide our education and empowerment programs. These devoted volunteers are the heart and soul of Women Blessing Women.

Numerous volunteers served on committees and actively assisted in planning and implementing fundraising events and projects.

### 2010 Fundraising Projects Earn Needed Funds

The successful fifth annual Spring Blessings Luncheon and Fashion Show, held on June 5, 2010, at Lourdes College, raised \$5,425, with some 200 guests attending.

The third annual Chili and Soup Fest, "Chili for Change and Soup for Success," featured many delicious chili and soup entries and included a bake sale and raffle. The event, held at Notre Dame Academy on Nov. 14, netted \$5,285.

Additional fundraisers raised dollars for the Endowment Fund and included the Glass Slipper Revue, "A Celebration of Women in the Performing Arts," held on Oct. 10, which raised \$3,088 and the Purse Auction on Dec. 15, \$948. The special holiday campaign held in Dec. earned \$4,078.

Other projects were Bob Evans (Monroe Street), Kevin Charles Salon (Sylvania, OH), Merle Norman Cosmetics (Sylvania, OH), and WBW Back-to-School fundraiser which brought in a total of \$1,111.

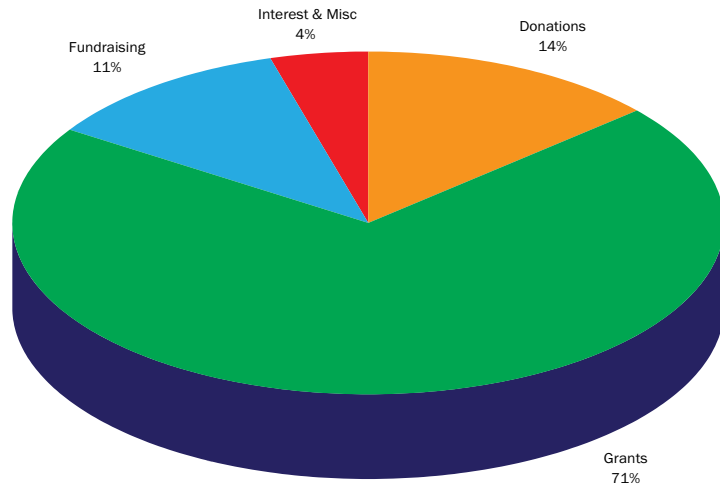

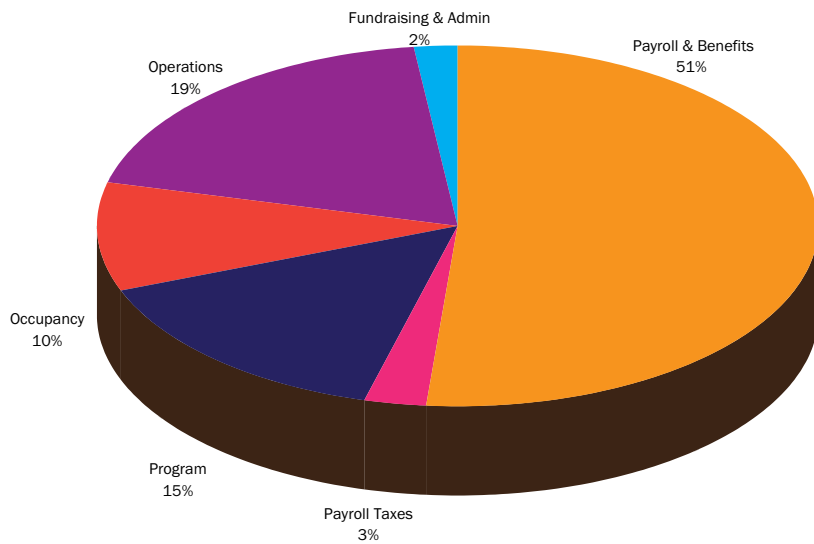

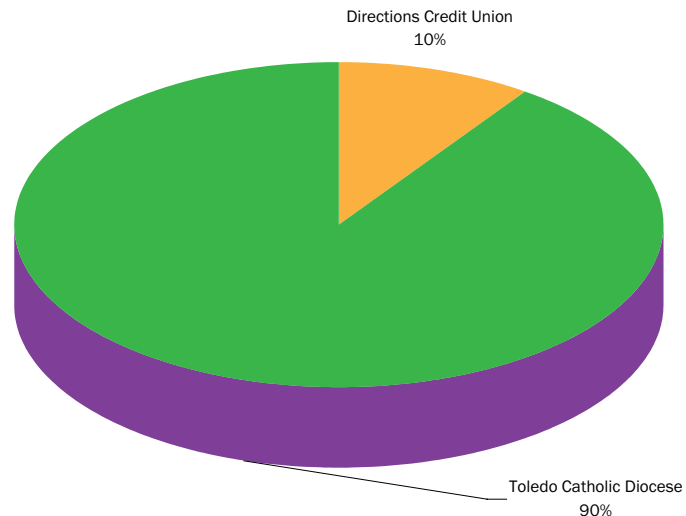
